Background:

To prepare for domestic use and exportation of its gas resources, Senegal must develop its gas infrastructure including gas fired power plants, a floating liquefaction natural gas unit, and distribution systems. Senegal will begin importing LNG to meet near-term demand while domestic gas is developed over the course of the next 6-7 years. Both Senegal and Mauritania are interested in importing LNG in the near term to reduce energy costs and to expedite the build-out of gas infrastructure and allow for a quick transition to domestic gas once it is available.
